We have hired eight new teammates in the past month in roles such as welders, field quality control inspector, technology expert, accounts payable, and a secretary.

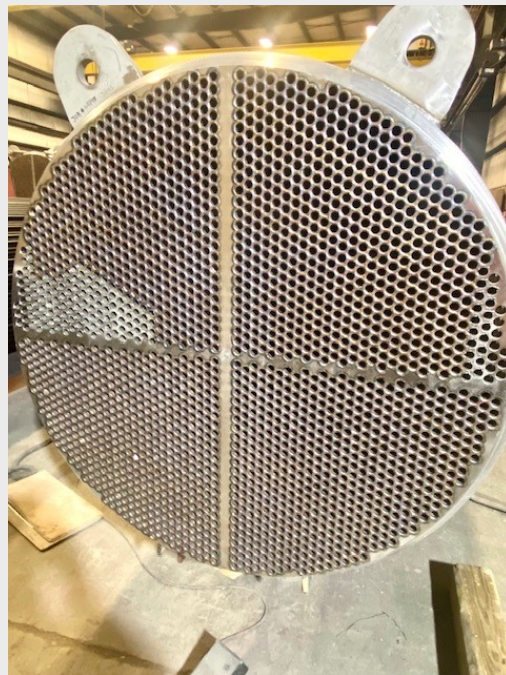

Weld Quality at the forefront

The Kennedy Tank team prides itself on our weld quality. We treat all vessels as ASME vessels and have a robust traveler system that entails all welders, foremen, and quality control checks off every step of the fabrication process. We shoot between 3,000 and 5,000 x-rays each year and pass over 95% on average.

To the left, you will see a production teammate nearing completion on 1,100 tube-to-tube sheet joints in which all welds passed a third-party helium leak test. Well done!

Our field tank erection crews remain busy currently erecting tanks in Ohio, Michigan, and Indiana. We should have crews available in the coming months if we can be of service to your team.
